



**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF WILLIAMSFIELD,
KNOX COUNTY, ILLINOIS
RELATING TO PART-TIME EMPLOYMENT OF POLICE**

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/3.1-30-21) allows a municipality to appoint, discipline, and discharge part-time police officers; and

WHEREAS, said statute further provides that a municipality that employs part-time police officers shall, by ordinance, establish hiring standards for part-time police officers and shall submit those standards to the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board; and

WHEREAS, said statute further provides that part-time police officers shall not be used as permanent replacements for permanent full-time police officers; and

WHEREAS, said statute further provides that part-time police officers shall be trained under the Intergovernmental Law Enforcement Officer's In-Service Training Act in accordance with the procedures for part-time police officers established by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board. A part-time police officer hired after January 1, 1996 who has not yet received certification under Section 8.2 of the Illinois Police Training Act shall be directly supervised; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Police Training Act (50 ILCS 705/8.2) requires a person hired to serve as a part-time police officer must obtain from the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board a certificate attesting to his or her successful completion of the part-time police training courses or a training program of similar content in hours which has been found acceptable by the board; or attesting to the Board's determination of the part-time police training course is unnecessary because of the officer's prior law enforcement experience; and

WHEREAS, the President and Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Williamsfield, Knox County, Illinois, wish to maintain compliance with the Illinois statutory mandate as aforesaid; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees has determined that the adoption of this Ordinance would be in the best interests of the Village and the public;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF WILLIAMSFIELD, KNOX COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1. RECITALS. The recitals listed above are incorporated in this Ordinance as the findings of the President and Board of Trustees.

SECTION 2. PART-TIME EMPLOYMENT OF POLICE. The Village Board may from time to time specify the number of regular, part-time, and special police officers to be employed by

the Village. Whenever a vacancy occurs, the Village President shall, subject to the approval of the Village Board, employ a new member to fill the position. In the case of emergency or in times of peril, danger, riot, or pestilence, or apprehension thereof, the Village President may appoint or employ special police officers to act during such emergency, subject to the approval of the Village Board at its next regular meeting.

Part-time police officers serve at the discretion of the Village, shall not have any property rights in said employment, and may be removed at any time. In accordance with the Illinois Pension Code (40 ILCS 5/3-109.a.1) part-time police officers shall not be eligible to participate in a fund created under Article 3 of the Illinois Pension Code.

A part-time police officer shall have all the responsibilities of a full-time police officer and such specific duties as directed from time to time, but the hours a part-time police officer may work within a calendar year is restricted.

Part-time police officers shall not be assigned to supervise or direct full-time police officers.

Part-time police officers shall be trained in accordance with the Police Training Act (50 ILCS 705/1 et seq.) and the rules of the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board.

Any person employed as a part-time police officer must at least meet the following standards:

- i. Have received certification under Section 8.2 of the Police Training Act (50 ILCS 705/8.2).
- ii. Be of good moral character, of temperate habits, of sound health, and physically and mentally able to perform assigned duties.
- iii. Be at least twenty-one (21) years of age.
- iv. Pass a background check.
- v. Possess a high school diploma or GED certificate.
- vi. Possess a valid State of Illinois driver's license.
- vii. Possess no prior felony convictions.
- viii. Any individual who has served in the U.S. military must have been honorably discharged.

SECTION 3. REPEALER. Any policy, resolution or ordinance of the village, or any part thereof, that conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. Should any provision of this Ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions will remain in full force and effect the same as if the invalid provision had not been a part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take full force and effect following its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 6. FILING CERTIFIED COPY. The Village Clerk is authorized and directed to provide a certified copy of this ordinance to the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board.


