

JOINT RESOLUTION AND AGREEMENT
between
VILLAGE OF WILLIAMSFIELD
and
SPOON RIVER CHAPTER,
NATIONAL SOCIETY DAUGHTERS OF THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the citizens in the Village of Williamsfield to preserve historic sites and allow community use of such sites; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Williamsfield shall accept ownership to the residence in Williamsfield, commonly known as the Caldwell House; and

WHEREAS, the Spoon River Chapter, National Society Daughters of the American Revolution wishes to encourage and assist the Village in preservation of the Caldwell House;

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY AGREED AND RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Village of Williamsfield shall accept ownership of the property commonly known as the Caldwell House. The ownership shall be in fee simple and shall not be subject to any restrictions on sale or use. The Village intends to preserve the house and allow community use of the premises for appropriate purposes unless the Village deems the ownership or use no longer viable.

2. The Spoon River Chapter NSDAR wishes to assist the Village in the care and supervision of the Caldwell House. The Spoon River Chapter NSDAR shall assist as follows:

Supervision: The Spoon River Chapter NSDAR shall supervise the use of the home.

Financial assistance: The Spoon River Chapter NSDAR shall contribute funds annually toward insurance and other costs incident to maintenance of the home.

Care: The Spoon River Chapter NSDAR shall assist in caring for the home.

3. The Village of Williamsfield shall be responsible in all other respects for the home.

4. This agreement shall continue until terminated by either party upon 60-day written notice.
